

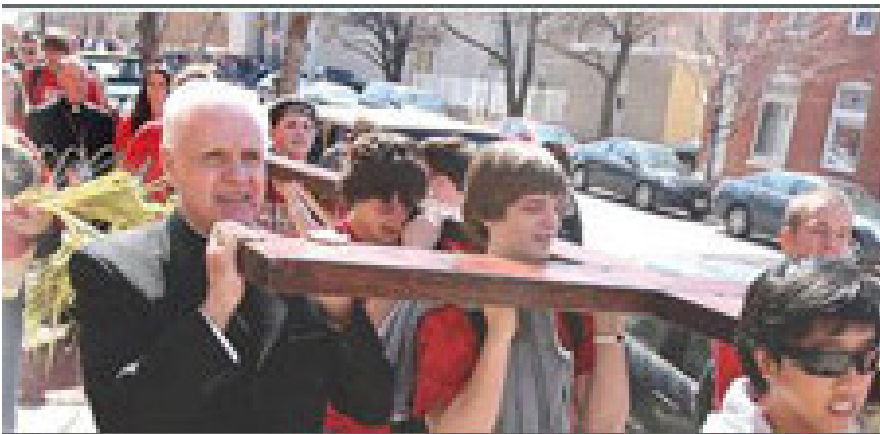

## **What is the Archdiocesan Youth and Young Adult Pilgrimage?**

It is a day of reflection, concert, energy, prayer and walking the road with Christ. Join hundred of other teens in a day of pilgrimage that is also a witness to the city of Baltimore.

**Archbishop Edwin O'Brien** invites all young adults [18 -35] and high school age youth to attend the Youth and Young Adult Pilgrimage. For the past fifteen years, hundreds of young adults and youth from the Archdiocese of Baltimore have commemorated Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem at the beginning of Holy Week by carrying palms and a cross, walking through the Inner Harbor and visiting the Basilica of the Assumption. The young church will again bear witness to their love of Jesus Christ, pray, and celebrate at the Youth and Young Adult Pilgrimage to be held on **March 27<sup>th</sup> 2010**. The total walk is 3 miles. We will leave from (parish/school) at 11:30 AM and return at 9:15 PM after Mass.

## **Who should attend?**

High School Youth and Young Adults. Those who went last year had a wonderful day! We want to invite you to attend as well, and if you cannot attend, please pray for your child in a special way during their Pilgrimage experience.

## **What is the cost?**

\$15 if you register with SPX.

## **What about food?**

Food **will not** be provided during the Pilgrimage experience by the Archdiocese. You will want to eat lunch before arriving at St. Casimir's Church. Pilgrims need to provide their own snacks which can be eaten throughout the walking portion of the day and pack a light meal for the evening. You will also want to pack at least one bottle of water.

## **What do I wear?**

Sturdy comfortable shoes and comfortable clothes. Layers are best since the weather can change. Sunscreen, a rain poncho, gloves and a hat- it is only April 4th !

## **What do I bring?**

Snacks, a light meal for the evening, water bottle, and gift cards to **Wal-mart, Target, Safeway, or Giant** for donation to Sarah's House, Anna's House, and Esperanza Center.
